What Sets Woodland Burials Apart?

An Undisturbed Permanent Resting Place

Unlike municipal and other cemeteries where often a shortterm lease only is acquired and graves can be subject to reuse, our burial grounds offer a permanent grave that will remain completely undisturbed.

Either Full Or Ashes Interment

We do not just offer full interment - we also inter ashes after cremation.

A Place For Friends And Family To Be At Peace

As the woodland develops it will become an increasingly attractive place for family and friends to visit.

A Beautiful Woodland Without Disruptions

Unlike traditional cemeteries that often fall into decay and disrepair there will be no unsightly broken or dangerous headstones.

A Religious Or Secular Burial

No particular form of service or any interment service is expected, the choice is left entirely to the family and can be formal or informal.

An Opportunity to be interred where You Choose

There are no By-Laws preventing persons from outside the Parish from being interred at our ground.

No Additional Levies

Some local authorities charge up to three times the normal fee for those who live outside their Parish and others do not allow interment unless you live in the catchment area.

No Shortage of Available Space

There is a national shortage of space in traditional cemeteries with the threat of increased re-usage or even burial "standing up"; we have no such problem.

An Opportunity for Family and Friends to Reserve Adjacent Plots

If reservations are made together, we can ensure that loved ones are buried in adjacent plots.

Reserve at Today's Prices

Reservations made today will peg the price at today's level and will be evidenced by a formal numbered Certificated receipt showing the right of interment.

A Hardwood Plaque inscribed with name and Lifespan

A hardwood plaque will mark the grave and can be replaced when it biodegrades.

A Site Management Scheme Approved By The Wildlife Trust

Woodland of Remembrance is managed in accordance with a scheme of management approved by Wildlife Trust and the local authority to ensure the development for the benefit of Wildlife and Insects.

A Nature Reserve and Habitat for Wildlife

Our management scheme will ensure that Oakfield Woodland of Remembrance will grow into a nature reserve and sanctuary for Wildlife.

General Terms And Conditions.

- 1) Full internments in shrouds or coffins made of cardboard, softwood or other similar readily biodegradable materials only are permitted.
- 2) Floral tributes will be removed after seven days following the date of burial.
- 3) A wooden plaque will be placed on the grave bearing details of the name and lifespan of the deceased, if provided.
- 4) Tree planting is undertaken by the Management in the dormant season.
- 5) Whilst every reasonable effort will be made to follow requests for the planting of a particular species of tree, the final selection will be made by the Management.
- 6) Nothing other than the provision of the plaque and tree will be permitted on the grave.
- 7) The Management Plan of the burial ground will be adopted as agreed from time to time with the relevant Wildlife Trust, other applicable Conservation Trust and/or the Local Authority and will be implemented at the sole discretion of the Management.
- 8)Reservations are conditional upon receipt of payment in full with completed Reservation Form and payment for plots at need is due prior to interment.
- 9) Reservations are conditional upon receipt of payment in full prior to interment, together with the completed Reservation Form and payments for plots required.
- 10) No refunds will be given after reservation, although the right of assignment may be available on production of the original Certificated Receipt, subject to written instructions given by the owner of the Right of Burial in such form as may be reasonably required by the management and to payment of an administration fee.
- 11) No interment will be permitted without the appropriate Registrar's Certificate or Coroner's Order for Burial.
- 12) No exhumation will be permitted under any circumstances, except by direction of a Court of Law.

Directions To Oakfield Wood Wrabness - Postcode CO11 2TF

Oakfield Wood Wrabness, lies beside the River Stour, between Manningtree and Harwich.

Directions From Colchester:

Take the A120 towards Harwich. 4 Miles after Horsley Cross roundabout turn left into Primrose Lane, at the large sign to Wrabness Station. At the crossroads go straight into Rectory Road/ Primrose Hill. At the Station follow round to the left into Station Road. Take the right over the railway bridge into Church Road. Pass the Church on your right, go round the left hand bend (and look at that view!). Oakfield Wood is down the hill about 200 yards on the right.

Directions From Ipswich:

Take the A137 to Manningtree. At the station turn left and pass through the town. Continue on the coastal road towards Harwich. Turn left at Bradfield Church on to the B1352. After 1.75miles (just after the Wrabness Village Sign) turn left onto Wheatsheaf Lane. Go down the hill, under the railway bridge. Oakfield Wood is on the left, after Wheatsheaf Close and Wall Lane.
